

Town of Shirley Board of Registrars  
Meeting Minutes

John Guthrie, Bob Huxley, Amy McDougall, and Carolynn K. Tohline were present. The meeting took place in the Town Clerk's Office at the Town Offices, 7 Keady Way.

The meeting began at 5:00pm.

Two elections were scheduled for November 6: the state election and a special town election (proposition 2 ½ override). Two elections would also be taking place on November 17: an election called by the Ayer Shirley Regional School District and a special debt exclusion town election; these two elections related to the renovation/addition project at the regional High School

Photocopies of the absentee ballot applications were attached to each ballot for the November 6 elections, and the original applications were left in the Town Clerk's office.
