The Commission opened a public hearing on a Request for Determination filed by Brian Healy to install a new septic tank to replace existing failed metal tank at 134 Conomo Point Road. Mr. John Judd of Gateway Consultants was in attendance to address the Commission. The Commission had no issues with the project as presented. On a motion made and duly seconded, the Commission voted unanimously close the public hearing. On a motion made and duly seconded, the Commission voted unanimously to issue a negative Determination.

The Commission opened a public hearing on a Request to Amend Order of Conditions DEP #021-0654 for the replacement of a failed cesspool with a 2000 gal tight tank at 46 Robbins Island Road. Mr. John Judd of Gateway Consultants was in attendance to address the Commission and explain the changes made to the plan originally filed. The Commission had no issues with the project as presented. On a motion made and duly seconded, the Commission voted unanimously to close the public hearing. On a motion made and duly seconded, the Commission voted to issue an Amended Order of Conditions.

The Commission opened a public hearing on a Request to Amend Order of Conditions DEP #021-0660 issued to replace metal septic tank and failed SAS with a 2000 gal tight tank at 38 Robbins Island Road and the Commission opened a public hearing on a Request to Amend Order of Conditions DEP #021-0679 issued to demolish and rebuild the current house and landscape work at 38 Robbins Island Road. Mr. Peter Levesque of Poore and Co. was in attendance to address the Commission and explain the changes to the two plans originally filed. The Commission had no issues with the changes made to the plans. On a motion made and duly seconded, the Commission voted unanimously to close the public hearing. On a motion made and duly seconded, the Commission voted unanimously to issue an Amended Order of Conditions.

The Clerk advised the Commission that the minutes of the meeting of December 18, 2018 were not available for approval but would be prepared for the next meeting.

There being no further business, on a motion made and duly seconded, the meeting was adjourned.
