Richard O'Brien opened the meeting at 4:05 p.m.

Minutes for the April 6, 2015 BOH meeting were reviewed. Edward Gero motioned to accept. Richard O'Brien seconded. All in favor.

**Sweet Occasions Food Application** – A plan to open a food establishment located at 164 Hinsdale Rd serving ice cream and candy was presented to the Board by Shelby Hiser. Chairman O'Brien stated questions regarding parking and zoning restrictions are outside BOH control and the owners were advised to contact the Zoning Board of Appeals. The shop layout and menu were discussed as well as issuing pertaining to the Federal Food Code. No soft serve ice cream which requires an additional permit is going to be served. A pre-inspection as well as a final inspection prior to opening will be performed by the Health Agent.

**Wahconah Falls Trailer Park Septic** – the Health Agent is scheduled to meet the engineer Brent White of White Engineering and the installer at the site on Friday May 8<sup>th</sup> to do a pre-construction walk through. Bob Bishop of the Conservation Commission will also attend.

**Natural Gas Pipeline Project** – no discussion.

**Pesticide Complaint** – Health Agent stated a resident has complained regarding pesticide overspray on the sidewalk around Pine Grove Park by TruGreen Lawn Care Company. The Dalton Housing Authority will be called to discuss the matter as they contracted the spraying.

**112 Warren Ave** – Owner has been ordered to remove the collapsing barn public nuisance by June 30<sup>th</sup> as directed by the Board of Health. The owner called the Health Agent to discuss the letter and was asked to attend the meeting tonight to address the Board with any questions.

**463 High St** – Housing situation ongoing. Nothing to report.

The next scheduled meeting is June 1, 2015. The meeting was closed at approximately 4:45 p.m.
