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The Commission opened a public Hearing on a Notice of Intent filed by the Town of Essex by Brendhan Zubricki, Town Administrator, to construct a public safety facility at 11 John Wise Avenue. Mr. Brendhan Zubricki opened the presentation and advised that the Board of Selectmen and the Design Team for the project were in attendance to address any question. He introduced Mr. Tyler Ferrick of DeRosa Environmental to make the presentation. The Commission expressed concerns regarding the use of underground infiltration systems and asked if the use of subsurface drainage basins might be a better alternative. It was agreed that the option of subsurface drainage basins would be researched and a revised plan submitted for review if it was a viable option. The Commission asked that the public hearing be continued to allow for this alternative to be considered and a new plan submitted. Mr. Zubricki agreed to the continuance on behalf of the Town. On a motion made and duly seconded, the Commission voted unanimously to continue the public hearing to the meeting of August 20, 2019.

The Commission reviewed Requests for Certificates of Compliance for 24 Apple Street and 9 Lufkin Point Road. The Agent recommended that both Certificates be issued. On a motion made and duly seconded, the Commission voted unanimously to issue the Certificates of Compliance discussed.

The Chairman presented the minutes of the meeting of July 9, 2019 for approval. On a motion made and duly seconded, the Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes as presented.

There being no further business, on a motion made and duly seconded, the meeting was adjourned.
