1. Minutes from June 9 and June 16 approved. Nelia will send to Tara.
2. We will be looking into CPC funding for the North Terrace Garden. Cheryl will work up a design and get a start on the text. The qualifying phrases are passive recreational and benefit to the community. The garden could be in place by April 2015. If we receive funding from other sources we could withdraw our application.
3. John will order plants and begin doing some work this week. The majority of the work will be done the week after the 4th of July weekend. Trees and ferns still need to be ordered, PHA plants are ready to be planted. The push is to get the plants in by July 13th, in time for the donor party on the 20th of July.
4. We still need formal approval from the ConCom and funding for clearing the South and West property lines.
5. Mowing: John Hoff will mow for the rest of the summer, paid by the Foundation. Beth will check with her budget and how that expense can be paid for after the summer, either by the Library or the Friends.
6. New irrigation pipes have to be laid underneath the front center walkway. Bricks will be lifted, the pipe will be laid and the bricks will be replaced.
7. Benches: the 5 6' benches have been ordered and paid for, they are being stored at Vineyard Decorators. John offered to pick them up when it was time to install them. Nelia will look into ordering 3 more, either 5' or 6' benches of the same or similar style. These may be placed temporarily in the back yard where the Noons'-Wood garden will be installed in the fall.
8. We may plan some screening trees along the path and the edge of the bioswale to shield the view of the library from the neighbors.
9. Our next meeting is July 14, 8:30AM at the Library
